












scientific abstracts submission

Please send the titles of your proposed articles (oral or poster communications), by February 15th 2018 the latest, and the abstracts will be sent electronically in Romanian and English by March 1st 2018, to events@trima.ro

ATTENTION: Prior to sending the abstract, please make sure that it respects the instructions below, if they don't the articles will not be published.

IMPORTANT: For the abstracts to be accepted and published, they must respect the following requirements:

- » title written in capital letters, no longer than 200 characters;
- » name of presenting author underlined;
- » the article must NOT contain diacritics or abbreviations, in care abbreviations are used, they will be explained;
- » the content will respect the known structure: introduction, material and method, results, conclusions;
- » there will be no inserts in the form of images, graphics or tables;
- » the abstract should not exceed one A4 page
